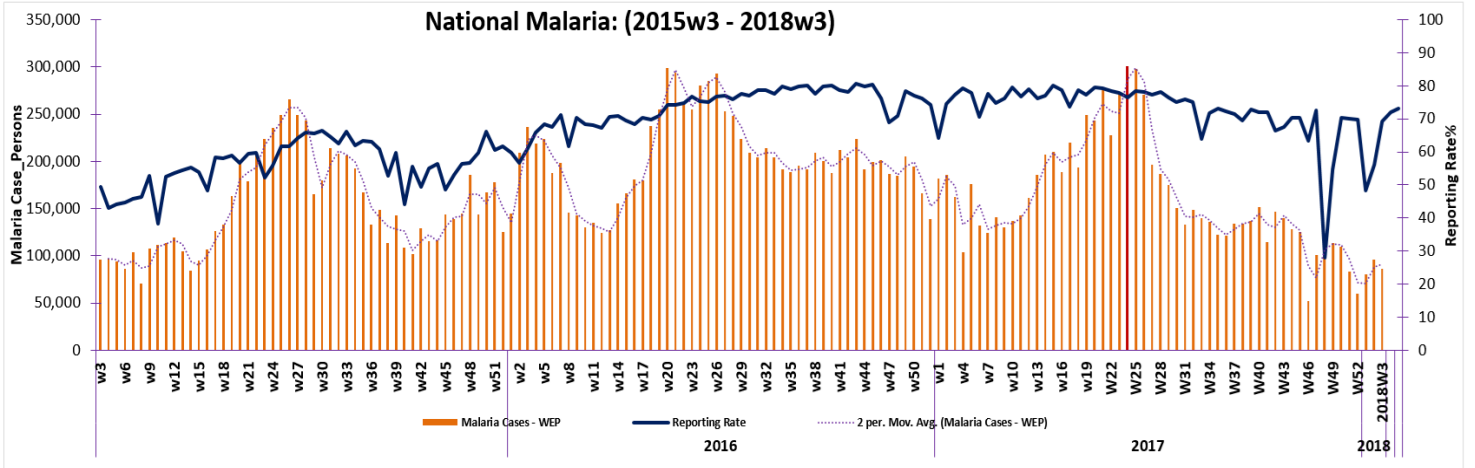
### Highlights

- Net distribution activities for Wakiso done and completed on 27th January 2018.
- Kisoro Upsurge response continues from the Ministry of Health and District. There is still limited support from malaria implementing partners. The cases have slightly reduced but remain above the epidemic threshold.
- Report got from Rwamanja HCIII in Kamwenge district of suspected malaria upsurge but facility data analysis confirmed no up-

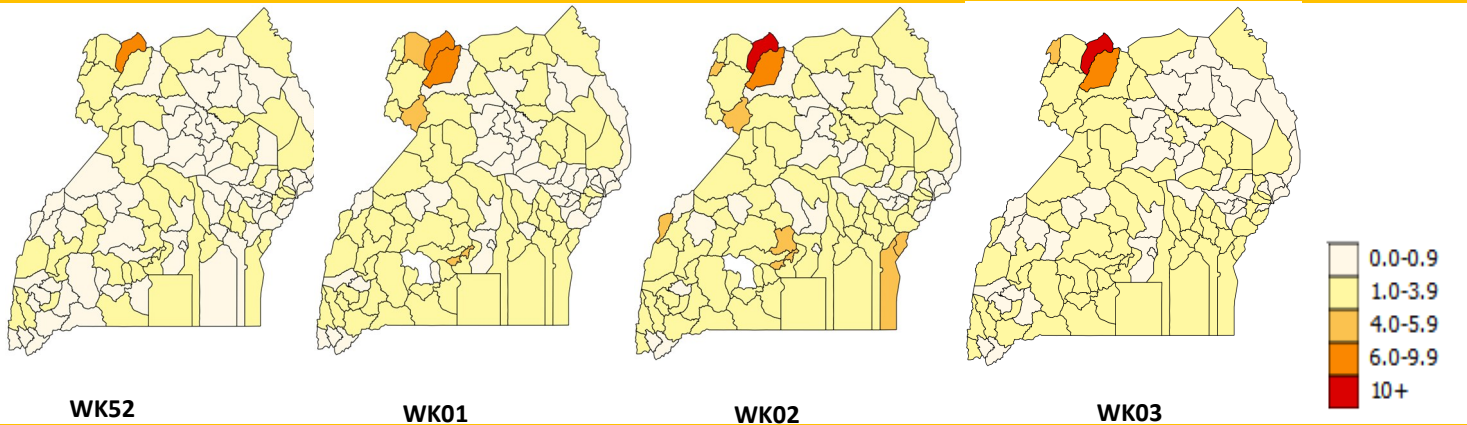

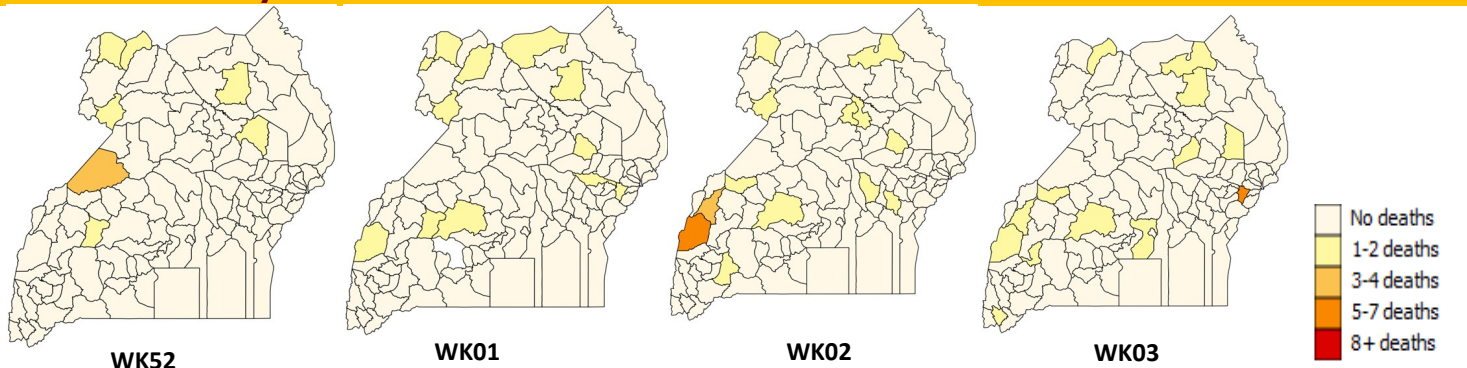
### Trends in Malaria reporting rates

### Trends in Weekly Malaria Deaths

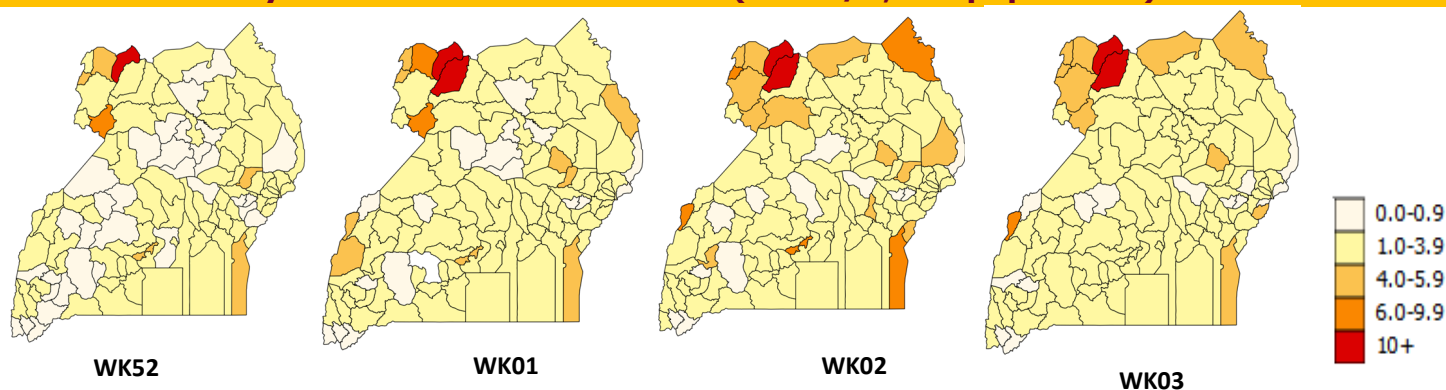

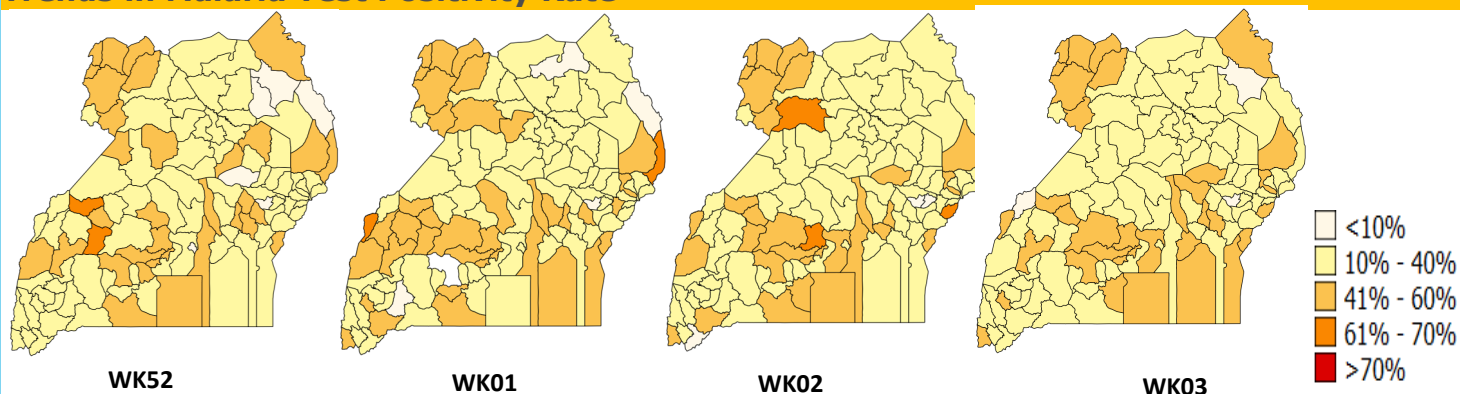

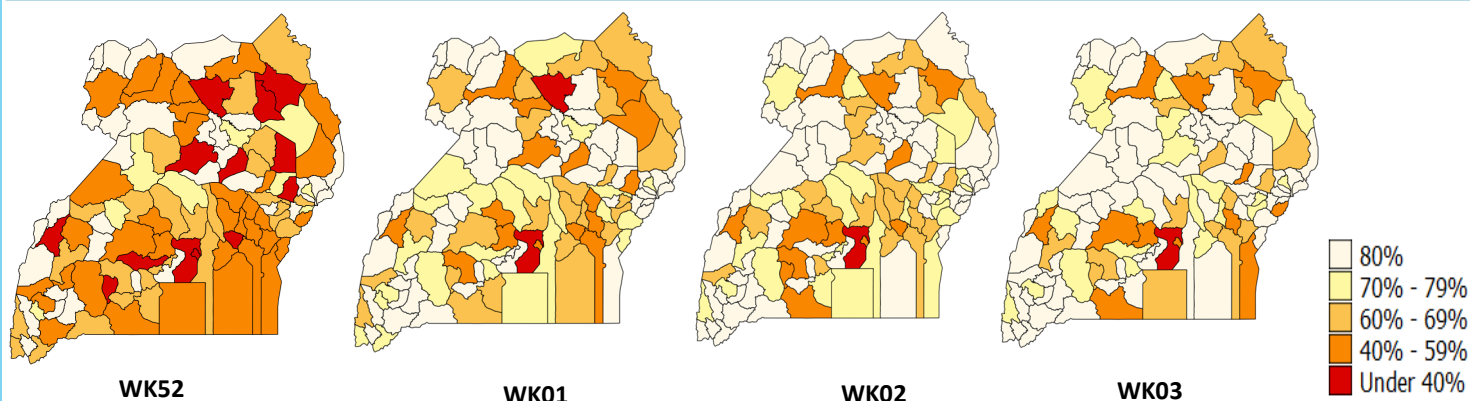
## Trends in Weekly Total Incidence of Malaria (Cases/1,000 population)



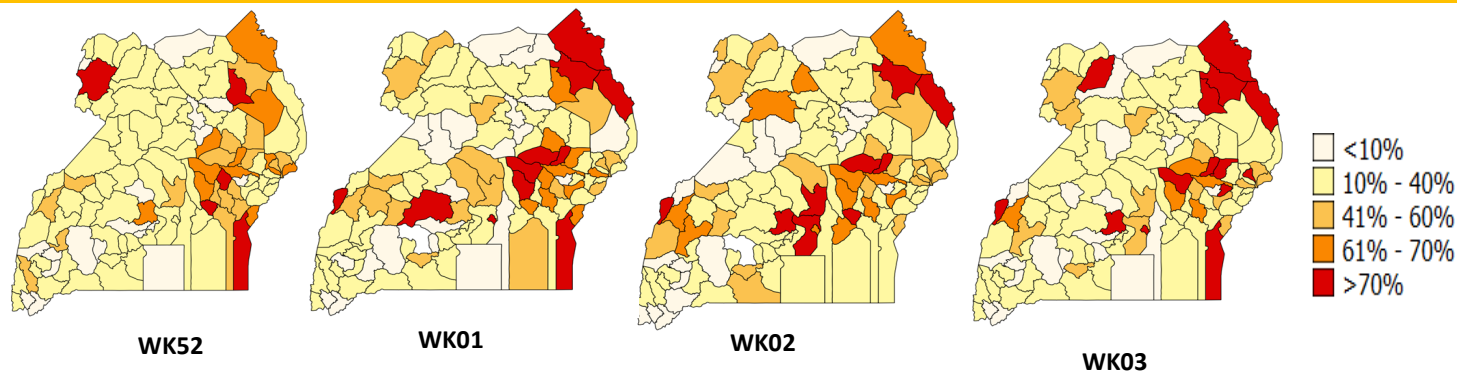
## Trends in Malaria Test Positivity Rate

## Detailed Observation in Review Period

- The incidence of confirmed malaria in the country has reduced although Moyo and Adjumani continue to have an incidence of above 10 cases per 1000 population.
- The National reporting rates in Week 3 was at 73% representing a 5% percentage point decline when compared to Week 3 in 2017
- Mbale Regional Referral Hospital reported the highest malaria deaths (6) in the period under review.
- In the past three weeks, Kaabong, Moroto, Kotido and Abim have had the highest percentage of over 70% of test negative cases treated.

## Recommendations and Actions taken on previous recommendations

- Mbale Regional Referral to review records and audit malaria deaths
- The National Malaria Control Program have allocated resources and planned IMM and clinical audit trainings and BCC for the Karamoja region to improve practice
- NMCP and Partners have increased support to Kisoro Outbreak. We are still having Zero malaria deaths
- Kyotera, Kaberamaido and Rubanda to follow up on health facilities reporting spurious deaths.
