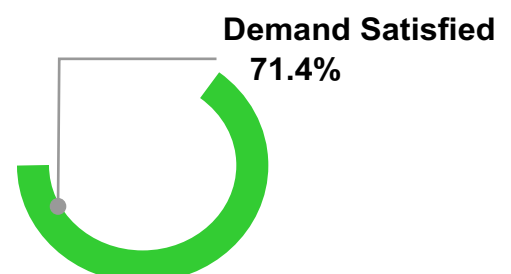
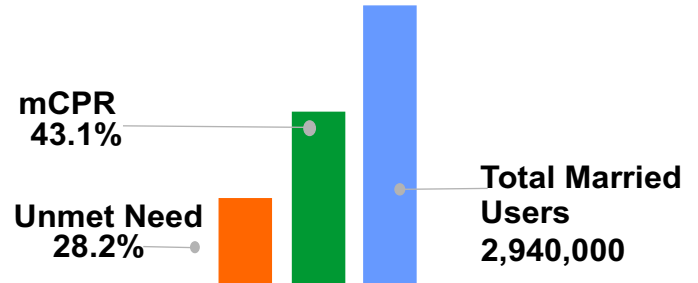
Uganda's AW mCPR goal reflects strong ambition

### High Level Indicators of Performance for Married Women

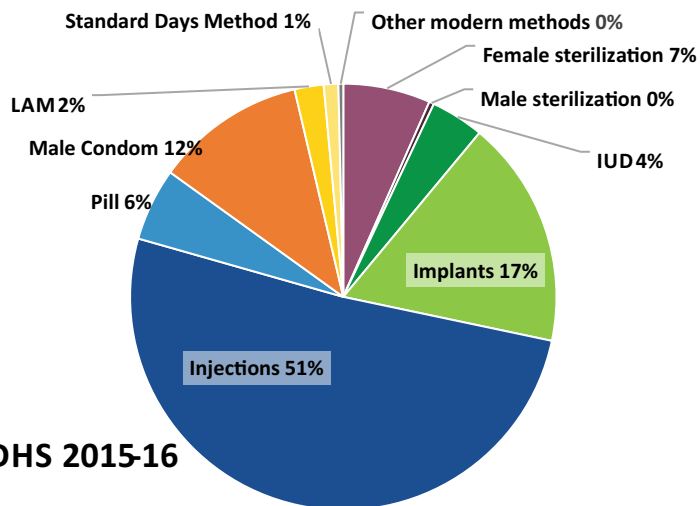
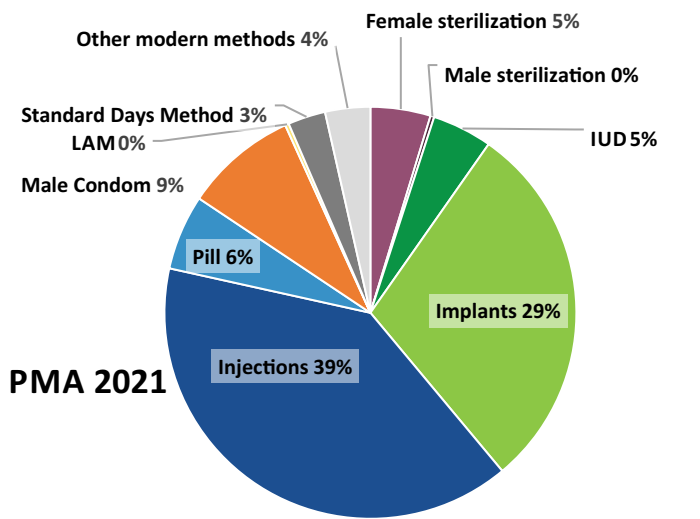

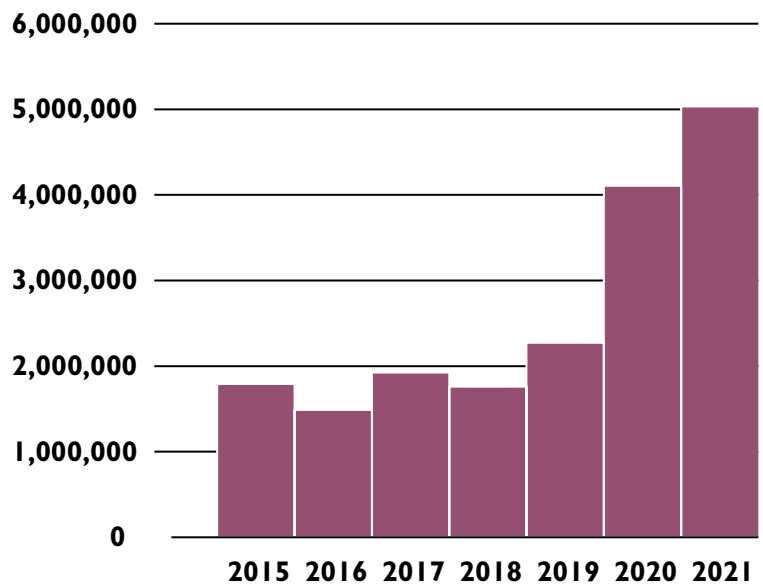
